

PREVENTIVE MAINTENANCE PROGRAM: CASE PACKERS

Each Preventive Maintenance visit includes the following:

- Visual inspection of all aspects of your machine to identify any prematurely worn parts, potentially failing or worn motors/cylinders and any loose electrical or pneumatic connections.
- Repair and tune-up as needed to bring your machine production levels back in line with its original capabilities and efficiency.
- Technician will update any documentation to reflect state of current machine including pneumatic and electrical prints and the bill of materials.
- Technician will review your spare parts inventory and provide recommendations to further safeguard from future unplanned downtime.
- Provide training for any operators who need it, and also brief the operations team on any newly available mechanical and software technologies.

WHEN SHOULD YOU LOOK AT ENROLLING IN A PM PLAN?

- If you notice a drop in operational efficiency (below 80%).
- If you're running a new product/SKU through the machine.
- If your machine has been in operation more than 1 year without undergoing any internal preventive maintenance.

Programs are fully customizable to coincide with your planned downtime schedule.
